What is Lean Library?

- A browser extension that delivers library-licensed content to the users, whenever and wherever they need it.
 - **Off campus:** prompts users to log in for access
 - **On & off campus:**
 - Provides article, e-book and OA alternatives, as well as ILL requests;
 - Displays customized messages from the library;
 - Integrates with tools such as Google Scholar & PubMed.

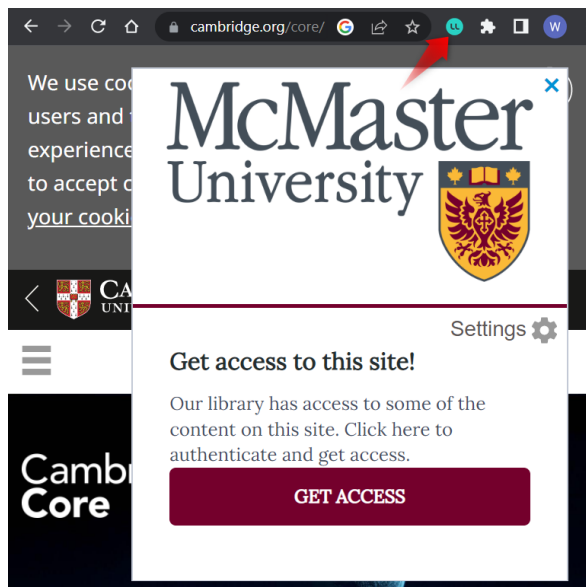

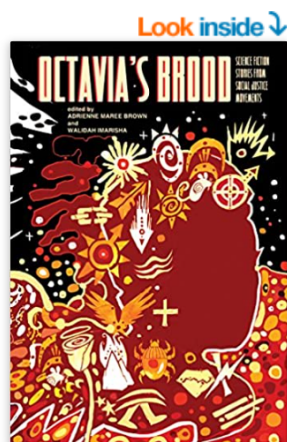

Hypatia^[a] (born c. 350–370; died 415 AD)^{[1][4]} was a **neoplatonist** philosopher, astronomer, and **mathematician**, who lived in **Alexandria, Egypt**, then part of the **Eastern Roman Empire**. She was a prominent thinker in Alexandria where she taught **philosophy** and **astronomy**.^[5] Although preceded by **Pandrosion**, another Alexandrine **female mathematician**,^[6] she is the first female mathematician whose life is reasonably well recorded.^[7] Hypatia was renowned her own lifetime as a great teacher and a wise counselor. She wrote a commentary on **Diophantus**'s thirteen-volume *Arithmetica*, which may survive in part, having been interpolated into Diophantus's original text, and another commentary on **Apollonius of Perga**'s treatise on **conic sections**, which has not survived. Many modern scholars also believe that Hypatia may have edited the surviving text of **Ptolemy**'s *Almagest*, based on the title of her father **Theon**'s commentary on Book III of the *Almagest*.

Hypatia constructed **astrolabes** and **hydrometers**, but did not invent either of these, which were both in use long before she was born. She was tolerant towards **Christians** and taught many Christian students, including **Synesius**, the future bishop of **Ptolemais**. Ancient source record that Hypatia was widely beloved by pagans and Christians alike and that she established great influence with the political elite in Alexandria. Towards the end of her life, in **Alexandria**, who was in the midst of a political feud with **Cyril**, the **bishop of Alexandria**. Rumors spread accusing her of preventing Cyril

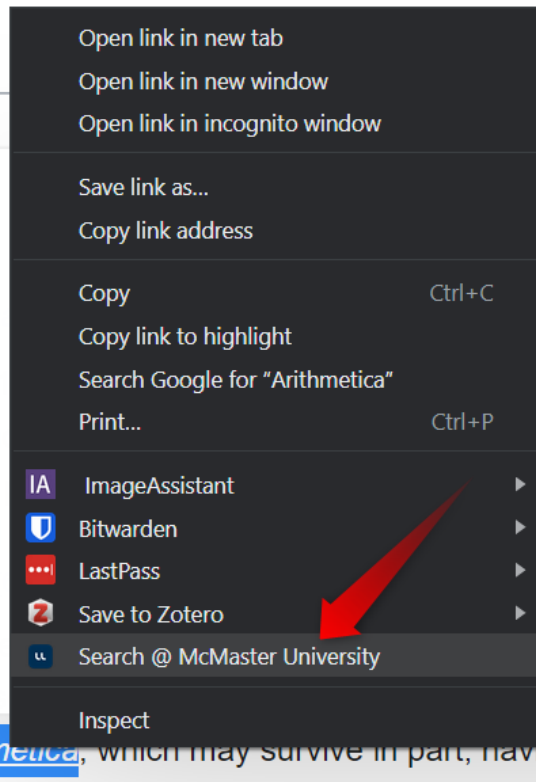





Lupus nephritis is an inflammation of the kidney in [systemic lupus erythematosus \(SLE\)](#), an autoimmune disease. In this condition, which the [glomeruli](#) become inflamed. Since it is a form of [glomerulonephritis](#) it is said to be *secondary*, and is distinguished from conditions with a *primary* cause originating in the kidney. Lupus nephritis depends on [blood tests](#), [urinalysis](#), [X-rays](#), [ultrasound](#) scans or the results of a [kidney biopsy](#). On urinalysis, a nephritic picture is found and [red blood cell casts](#), [red blood cells](#) and [proteinuria](#) is found.

The [World Health Organization](#) has divided lupus nephritis into five stages based on the results of a [kidney biopsy](#). This classification was defined in 1982 and revised in 1995.^{[5][6]} Class IV disease ([Diffuse proliferative nephritis](#)) is both the most severe, and the most common subtype. Class VI (advanced sclerosing lupus nephritis) is a final class which is included by most practitioners. It is thought to be due to the chronic [interferon](#) exposure.^[7]



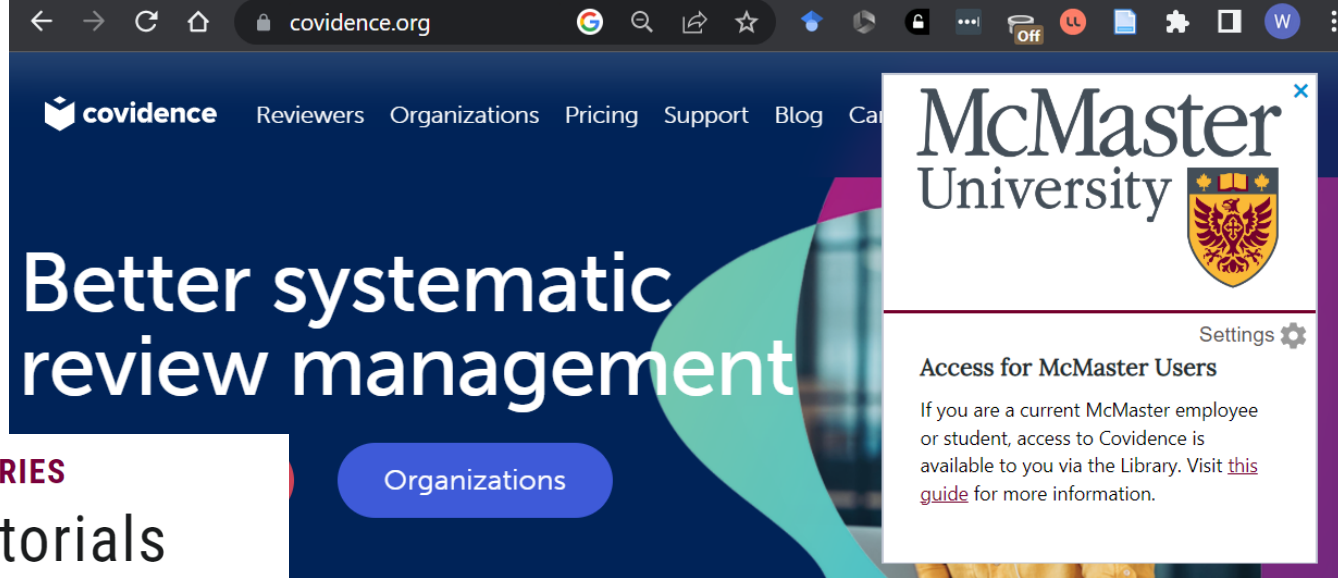
